1. This is an expression of interest only, and not a guarantee of acceptance
2. We reserve the right to refuse an application or restrict your product list.
3. On acceptance to the event a stall fee will apply of *\$50per Stall to be paid 7 days prior to event*
4. **Stall holders need to do the following.**
 - a. Must have an Entertainment from community/church/youth Groups is a must
 - a. Theming – *Your stall must be themed in Pacific ways or styles*
 - b. Promotion – *you must actively promote the event via networks and social media platforms*
 - c. Power leads – *Minimum 30m long we will provide power*
 - d. Fee - *\$50.00 for all stall holders*
 - e. If your stall has sold out * ***You cannot pack down your stall it must remain standing until 3.30pm***
 - f. All stallholders MUST provide hand sanitizer for customers.
 - g. In line with our COVID-19 Response Plan - EFTPOS for cashless transactions is encouraged but not mandatory.
5. **Rubbish**
 6. Any rubbish around your stall and all attendees to the event may dispose rubbish in bins provided on-site. Make sure you leave your area tidy at the end of the day.
 7. You agree to sell only those items on Menu/product list as approved by us.
 8. You are entitled to access your site from 7.00am until 5.00pm on the day of the event.



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9. You must be completely set up and ready to trade at 10.00am – when the event commences
10. You shall not sell or provide alcoholic beverages at the event. You are entitled to sell non-alcoholic beverages under this Application.
11. No vehicles will be able to sit behind your stall or on the fields. They will need to be positioned in the parking area as allocated.
12. You stock for the event at your own risk. We will not be held liable for any loss made by you through cancellation or other factors.
13. Compliance with all health and safety and food safety laws and regulations are your responsibility.
14. The stallholder is not entitled to any reimbursement in respect of any event or circumstance that prevents, delays, suspends and/or disrupts the event, including without limitation inclement weather.
15. Temperature/storage/transportation of all foods for fundraising for Not for Profit Organisations under Food Act 2014 Hand washing facilities onsite in your stall provided by you.
